

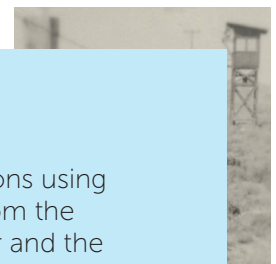
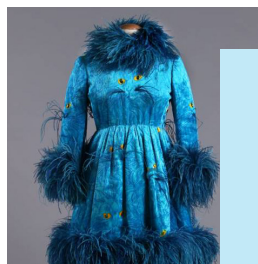
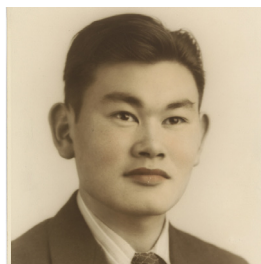
# The Smithsonian Is Coming to Cleveland!
